



CHAPTER II (MEMBERSHIP)

Article 10 (Qualification)

Section 1 (Eligibility for Membership)

Regular membership in the Corporation is open to individuals who are 18 years of age or older and who are legally residing within the Corporation's official Jurisdiction of the Corporation as defined in Article 6 (Jurisdiction) of the Bylaws. Eligible individuals include citizens of the Republic of Korea, those recognized as "Overseas Koreans" under the Korean Overseas Koreans Act (Revised February 4, 2020), and the spouse or direct descendant of such citizens or Overseas Koreans. Furthermore, individuals wishing to apply for regular membership must meet any other criteria established by the Board of Directors.

Section 2 (Honorary Membership)

Individuals who do not meet the eligibility criteria for regular membership but are 18 years of age or older, legally residing within the Corporation's Jurisdiction defined in Article 6 (Jurisdiction) of the Bylaws, and agree with the Corporation's objectives and purposes may be granted honorary membership with the approval by the Board of Directors. Those who have made notable contributions to the Korean community may also qualify for honorary membership. Honorary members shall enjoy the same rights as regular members, including voting rights and the right to participate in elections.

Section 3 (Membership Regulations)

The Board of Directors shall establish detailed regulations regarding membership, including but not limited to eligibility, application procedures, membership dues, and other relevant matters. These regulations shall comply with the provisions of the Bylaws and applicable laws.



Article 11 (Rights and Duties)

Section 1 (Rights of Members)

Members of the Corporation are entitled to participate in all activities and events of the Corporation. They have the right to attend the General Assembly, express their opinions, and vote. In accordance with CHAPTER XI (ELECTION) of the Bylaws, they also have the right to vote and run as a candidate in the presidential elections.

Section 2 (Entitlement to Publications and Reports)

Members have the right to receive the Corporation's publications and reports and to inspect corporate meeting minutes and operational records. However, access to personnel, financial, confidential, or trade secret-related information may be restricted by the decision of the Board of Directors.

Section 3 (Obligations of Members)

Members are required to comply with the Bylaws and related regulations and to adhere to resolutions passed at meetings of the Corporation. Members are also obligated to pay membership dues and contributions.

Article 12 (Removal and Resignation)

Section 1 (Resignation)

A member may voluntarily terminate their membership by submitting a written resignation request. The resignation takes effect immediately upon submission.

Section 2 (Removal by Board of Directors)

A member may be expelled by a resolution of the Board of Directors if they engage in any of the following actions:

1. Seriously damaging the honor and reputation of the Corporation, thereby significantly undermining its credibility.

2. Violating the fundamental purpose and principles of the Bylaws and the Corporation.
3. Intentionally obstructing the operations of the Corporation.
4. Repeatedly failing to fulfill membership obligations.

Section 3 (Mediation)

An expelled member may submit a written objection and request mediation from the Mediation Commission within ten (10) days of receiving the expulsion notice.
